### Administrative history / Biographical sketch

#### Note

Dr TB Davie (1895-1955) was Principal and Vice-Chancellor of the University of Cape Town between 1948 and 1955. He was a staunch opponent of the extension of apartheid in university education and was prominent in resisting the curtailing of academic freedom.

#### Scope and content

The collection comprises miscellaneous material, such as personal documents related to Davie's medical career, correspondence, photographs, newspaper clippings, photographs, notes, speeches and addresses given as Vice-Chancellor, publications, as well as letters of condolence and obituaries. BC7
